BANK NOTES.

Restriction of Issue.

O. in C. 29 of 1944.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

made by the Governor in Council under section 17 on the 20th June, 1944.

- 1. This order may be cited as the Bank Notes (Restriction of Issue) Order.
- 2. As respects the Royal Bank of Canada, it is directed that on and after the 1st July, 1944, the nominal value of bank notes issued under the Bank Notes Ordinance by that banker and for the time being in circulation shall not at any time exceed such sum as, together with the aggregate nominal value of bank notes issued by that banker and for the time being in circulation in Trinidad and Tobago, Barbados, the Windward Islands, the Leeward Islands, and Jamaica including the Turks and the Caicos Islands and the Cayman Islands, amounts to the sum of one million two hundred and ninety-three thousand dollars, that is to say, the sum of two hundred and sixty-nine thousand three hundred and seventy-five pounds sterling.
