IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 8 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana National Trading Corporation (Transfer of Property) Order 1992 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 30th December, 1991.

Inter-  
pretation.

2. In this Order —

- (a) "Agreement" means the agreement made on the 27th September, 1991 between the Corporation and the Purchaser;
- (b) "appointed day" means the day on which this Order comes into operation;
- (c) "Corporation" means the Guyana National Trading Corporation, being a public corporation established under the Public Corporations Act 1988;
- (d) "property" means the property described in the Schedule, being property belonging to the Corporation;

(e) "Purchaser" means Colonial Life Insurance Company (Trinidad) Limited, being a company duly incorporated in Trinidad and Tobago under the laws of that country, and having in accordance with section 259 of the Companies Act established its registered office at 1 Avenue of the Republic, Georgetown, Demerara, Guyana.

3. Pursuant to the Agreement and subject to the representations, covenants and the terms and conditions specified therein, the property, the possession of which has already been given pursuant to the Agreement, is hereby transferred to the Purchaser.

### SCHEDULE

1. A piece or parcel of land, being part or portion of the south half of mud lot numbered 15 (fifteen), situate in the town of New Amsterdam, in the county of Berbice, and Republic of Guyana, the said lot being shown and delineated on a plan by L. S. Hohenkirk, Government Surveyor, dated 21st May, 1902, and deposited in the Deeds Registry at New Amsterdam on the 11th day of June, 1903, and the said piece or parcel of land containing an area of .7127 of an acre and being shown and defined on a plan by D. C. S. Moses, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 27th July, 1956 and deposited in the Deeds Registry at New Amsterdam on the 22nd day of August, 1956, with the building and erections thereon.

2. The northern half of the Water or Mud Lot number 16 (sixteen) in the first Empolder of the Town of New Amsterdam, in the county of Berbice, and Republic of Guyana, with the buildings and erection thereon.
