## THE LABOUR ACT

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Employees at Petrol Filling Stations) Order 1977\*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Employees at Petrol Filling Stations) (Amendment) Order 1994, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 15th February, 1994.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the Schedule thereto of the Schedule hereto.
