IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Shirt and Garment Workers) Order*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Shirt and Garment Workers) (Amendment) Order 1994, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 15th February, 1994.
