THE ROADS ACT

(Cap. 51:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3
OF THE ROADS ACT, I HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:—

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of Public Road
(Clonbrook and Ann's Grove and Two Friends Road) Order 1980.

Amendment 2. The Schedule to the Act is amended by substituting the
to the following paragraph—
Schedule.

“The road known as the Clonbrook and Ann's Grove and Two Friends Road, situate in the county of Demerara on the sideline dam between Clonbrook and Ann's Grove and Two Friends, commencing from its intersection with the East Coast Demerara Public Road and extends in a southerly direction along the said sideline dam for a distance of 4.88 miles to its intersection with the East Demerara Water Conservancy Dam.”

for the paragraph —

“The road leading to the railway station at Clonbrook on the East Coast of Demerara extending from the main Public Road along that portion of the sideline dam between Clonbrook and Ann's Grove and Two Friends and running across Clonbrook and Ann's Grove and Two Friends to the steps of the platform of the aforesaid railway station,”
appearing under the heading “Demerara” of the said Schedule.
