MAGISTRATES' COURTS MONEY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1937.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction Short title. Magistrates (Amendment) Money Regulations, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Money Regulations, 1931, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
- 2. Regulations four, five, six, seven and eight of the Principal Regulations are hereby repealed and the following substituted:—
- "Fees and costs to be paid in Money.
- 4. In accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Amendment Ordinance, 1937, all fees and costs shall be collected in money except where otherwise specifically provided by any Ordinance.

Repeal and re-enactment of Regulations 4 to 8 of the Principal Regulations. No money to 5. No money shall be collected in respect of be collected in any document or instrument which is by law free process, ordered to be free of costs or in respect of any process issued free by the Magistrate. In all such cases the exemption from costs and the reason for such exemption shall be noted by the Magistrate on such document, instrument or process.

Receipts to be made out for all fees and for all money and costs received at Magistrates' Courts.

Receipts to be made out on the preseribed forms.

7. Receipts shall be made out on the prescribed forms in triplicate copies the original of which shall be handed to the payer and the duplicate attached to the case jacket or process in respect of which the fees and costs have been paid. The triplicate copy shall be retained in the receipt book.

Magistrates to check correctness of the fees and costs as indicated by the duplicate copy of the receipt attached to the case jacket or process in respect of all matters coming before him."

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the first day of January, 1938.
