- UNDER SECTION 9(2) OF THE ACCIDENTS AND OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES (NOTIFICATION) ORDINANCE, 1955, THE FOLLOW-ING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Accidents and Occupational Diseases (Notification) Regulations, 1956.
- 2. The following diseases are hereby declared to be occupational diseases for the purposes of the Accidents and Occupational Diseases (Notification) Ordinance, 1955—

Lead, phosphorous, arsenical mercurial, or other form of metallic poisoning; Anthrax.
