THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, (Chapter 132)

UNDER SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Official Inland Correspondence (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Official Inland Correspondence Regulations, 1955* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any Regulations amending the same.
- 2. The second schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after the item "The Secretary, Central Housing and Planning Department" under the heading "Housing and Planning" of the following new items:—

"Community Organisers.

Foremen."
