IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE ELECTIONS COMMISSION BY SECTION 19 OF THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION ACT, CAP. 19:08, THE COMMISSION HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

- 1. Citation.
- 2. Amendment of the Principal Regulations.

Citation

1. These Regulations, which amend the National Registration (Residents) Regulations may be cited as the National Registration (Residents) (Amendment) Regulations 2006.

Amendment of regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations.

- 2. Regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after paragraph 3 of the following paragraph $-\,$
 - "(4) If by reason of age, illness, infirmity or other physical incapacity it is impracticable for a person to comply with the provisions relating to the registration of persons or to claims and objections, the registration officer, on the direction of the Commissioner shall, before, during or after the end of the period for registration or the period for claims and objections, visit that person at his home, nursing home or hospital in order to effect his complete registration process, if necessary, or to rectify his particulars in his registration record with a view of his being placed on the register of registrants or on the electoral roll."
