THE PRESIDENT'S COLLEGE ACT 1990 (No. 11 of 1990)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 22 OF THE PRESIDENT'S COLLEGE ACT 1990, I MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Cration and commencement 1. This Order may be cited as the Upper Corentyne Industrial Training Centre (Board of Governors) Order 2007 and shall come into operation 1st September 2007.

Interpretation.

2. In this Order "technical institution" means the Upper Corentyne Industrial Fraining Centre referred to in clause 3(1).

Application of certain provisions of the Act

- 3. (1) The provisions of the Act, other than sections 1, 2, 3 (1), 10 and 22 shall mutatis mutandis apply in relation to the technical institution known as the Upper Corentyne Industrial Training Centre and for that purpose shall be read and construed with any necessary modifications, and, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, subject, in particular for the purpose of such application to the modifications in paragraph (3).
- (2) The technical institution shall be administered and maintained by a Board of Governors, which shall be a body corporate.
- (3) The following are the modifications referred to in paragraph (1) for sections, 7.8,9 and 13 the following sections shall respectively be substituted -

Of the Patrice of the Patrice metals, on,

- 7. The objectives of the technical institution are -
 - (a) to offer education and training in technical subjects in both day and evening classes to persons (including persons with disabilities) lifteen years and above;
 - (b) to ensure as far as possible, that graduates from the technical institution can enter directly into industry, and perform with the minimum of further orientation; and

(c) to liaise with Industry, Commerce and interested agencies, to assess their needs and adjust course contents and subject areas in an attempt to satisfy their needs by the output of students.

Eligibility.

8. Students who are citizens of Guyana shall be eligible for admission to the technical institution.

Admission of students.

9. A student shall not be admitted to the technical institution unless he has attained the required age and qualifications as determined by the Minister.

Vesting of assets in the Board of Governors 13. The assets (whether movable or immovable property, including rights and interest) belonging to the State in relation to the technical institution to which this Order applies are vested in the Board of Governors of the technical institution."
