PRELIMINARY

Short title.

1. This Act, which amends the Procurement Act 2003, may be cited as the Procurement (Amendment) Act 2010.

2. Section 6(1)(a) of the Principal Act is amended by the insertion immediately after the word "circulation" the words "or on a website of free access where Government procurement opportunities are displayed".

3. Section 27(3) of the Principal act is amended by the insertion immediately after the word "circulation" the words "or on a website of free access where Government procurement opportunities are displayed".

Amendment of
section 30 of
the Principal
Act.

4. Section 30 of the Principal Act is amended as follows -
(a) in subsection (1) by the insertion immediately after the word "circulation" the words "or on a website of free access where Government procurement opportunities are displayed".
(b) in subsection (2) by the insertion immediately after the word "contract" the words "or on a website of free access where Government procurement opportunities are displayed".

5. Section 44 of the Principal Act is amended as follows -
(a) in subsection (1) by the insertion immediately after the word "circulation" the words "or on a website of free access where Government procurement opportunities are displayed".
(b) in subsection (2) by the insertion immediately after the words "international circulation" the words "or on a website of free access where Government procurement opportunities are displayed".
