AN ACT to amend the Valuation for Rating Purposes Act.

Amendment of section 43 of the Principal Act 9. Section 43 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution in subsection (2) for the words "two hundred and fifty dollars" of the words "twenty thousand dollars".

Amendment of the First Schedule to the Principal Act. 10. The First Schedule to the Principal Act is hereby deleted.

Amendment of the Second Schedule to the Principal Act. 11. The Second Schedule to the Principal Act is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "Second" in the heading.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 2 of the Bill seeks to update the law by amending section 4 of the Valuation for Rating Purposes Act, Cap. 28:04, substituting for the words "District Commissioner under the District Government Act" the words "Regional Executive Officer under the Local Democratic Organs Act 1980".

Clause 5 seeks to amend the Act by deleting the valuation based on the annual rental value of properties in the urban areas. This clause amends section 10 of the Act by creating the valuation standard that is, the capital value standard, for properties in both urban and rural areas. So also with the repeal of the First Schedule by clause 10 and the re-naming of the Second Schedule a the Schedule to the Act there is ushered in as the valuation for all properties urban and rural, the capital value of such properties determined in accordance with the Schedule.

The remaining clauses of the Bill, seek to amend the Valuation for the Rating Purposes Act, Car 28:04, by increasing the penalties for various offences thereunder.
