AN ACT to amend the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Act.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title. Cap, 82:21

1. This Act, which amends the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Act, may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (No. 2) Act 1992.

Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Act.

- 2. Section 2 of the Principal Act is hereby amended in the following respects
 - (a) by the renumbering of it as subsection (1) and in and in subsection (1) as so renumbered
 - (i) by the insertion after the words "In this Act—" of the following definition—
 "alcohol" means ethyl alcohol;"
 - (ii) in the definition of "by wholesale", by the substitution for the words "forty-five gallons", "twenty gallons", and "forty gallons" of the words "two hundred and four litres", "ninety litres" and "one hundred and eighty-one litres" respectively;
 - (iii) by the insertion after the definition of "Intoxicating Liquor" of the following definition —
 - "litre" means the litre as defined by any written law;
 - (iv) in the definition of "malt liquor", by the substitution for the words "twenty percent or less than two and a half percent of proof spirit" of the words "eleven decimal four percent or less than one decimal four percent of alcohol";

- (v) by the deletion of the definitions of "proof" and "quart";
- (vi) in the definition of "spirituous liquor", by the substitution for the words "twenty percent of proof spirit" of the words "eleven decimal four percent of alcohol";
- (vii) by the insertion of the following definition after the definition of "spirituous liquor"—
 - "strength", in relation to any liquor means its alcoholic strength computed in accordance with this section and the ratio referred to in subsection (2) (c) being expressed as a percentage;";
- (viii) in the definition of "wine", by the substitution for the words "forty-two percent or less than four percent of proof spirit" of the words "twenty-four percent or less than two decimal three percent of alcohol";
- (b) by the insertion, after subsection (1) as so renumbered, of the following subsection as subsection (2)
 - "(2) For the purposes of this Act
 - (a) except where some other measure of quantity is specified, any computation of the quantity of any liquor shall be made in terms of the volume of the liquor or alcohol as the case may be;
 - (b) any computation of the volume of any liquor or of the alcohol contained in any liquor shall be made in litres as at 20° celsius; and
 - (c) the alcoholic strength of any liquor shall be the ratio of the volume of the alcohol contained in the liquor to the volume of the liquor (inclusive of the alcohol contained therein)."

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Act, Cap. 82:21, to change the method by which the strength of any liquor is determined so as to conform with the International Organisation of Legal Metrology ((OIML) system of Alcoholometry. As a result of the amendment sough to be made, all units of Imperial weights and measures pertaining to goods containing alcohol are changed to Metric Units.
