Short title. Cap. 16:05 1. This Act, which amends the Firearms Act, may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1993.

Amendment of, section 19 of the Principal Act.

- 2. Section 19 (1) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraphs (a), (b) and (c), of the following paragraphs
 - "(a) in respect of each rifle or gun, other than that referred to in paragraph (c), or combined rifle and shot gun —

\$3,000.00

(b) in respect of a pistol or revolver

\$2,000.00

(c) in respect of a shot gun —

\$1,000.00

Amendment of section 24 of the Principal Act. 3. Section 24 (2) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "five hundred dollars", of the words "five thousand dollars".
