# **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

This Bill seeks to make provision for the holding of local government elections.

Clause 2 of the Bill amends the Local Authorities (Elections) Act, Cap. 28:03, to provide that each people's co-operative unit shall be deemed to be a registration division and a polling division; that the registrar shall compile the preliminary hist of voters from the official list of electors prepared for the last general electons; that there shall be local observers to the elections; that a number of important functions vested in the Chief Election Officer shall be transferred to the Elections Commission; that there shall be counting of the votes at the place of poll.

Clauses 3 and 4 amend the Local Democratic Organs Act 1980 (No. 12 of 1980) to provide for a four tier, instead of a six tier system of local government, making the neighbourhood democratic council the primary local government.

Clause 6 applies the provisions of the Local Authorities (Elections) Act 1990 (No. 10 of 1990) to elections to neighbourhood democratic councils.

Clause 7 provides for external observers by applying the provisions of the Observers Act 1990 (No. 17 of 1990) to local government elections.

Clause 8 provides for scrutineers by applying the provisions of section 3E of the Election Laws (Amendment) Act 1990 (No. 25 of 1990) to local government elections).

Clause 9 repeals the Local Democratic Organs (Elections) Act 1990 (No. 22 of 1990).
