Short title Cap. 51:01: 1. This Act, which amends the Roads Act may be cited as the Roads (Amendment) Act 1996.

Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Act

2. Section 2 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution of the following definition for the definition of "Chief Officer"

"Chief Officer" means the Chief Works Officer;".

Amendment of section 31 of the Principal Act, 3. Section 22 (2) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "fifteen dollars" of words "fifteen thousand dollars".

Amendment of section 25 of the Principal Act. 4. Section 25 (3) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "one hundred and fifty dollars" and "thirty dollars" of the words "fifteen thousand dollars" and "three thousand dollars", respectively.

Amerylment of section 26 of the Principal Act, 5. Section 26 (1) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "seven hundred and fifty dollars" of the words "fifty thousand dollars".

Insertion of new section 39 in the Principal Act.

6. The Principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion of the following section immediately after section 38 —

"Amendment of fine 39. Nothwithstanding anything in this Act, where under this Act, there is prescribed or annexed any fine for a breach of any provision of this Act or any regulation made under this Act, the Minister may by regulation which shall be subject to negative resolution of the National Assembly, amend such fine.".

This Bill seeks to re-define "Chief Officer" and increase the fines for offences under the Roads Act, Cap. 51:01. The Bill also seeks to enable the Minister to amend by regulation which shall be subject to negative resolution of the National Assembly, any fine prescribed by, or annexed to any regulation made under, the said Act.,
