It is considered equitable that the service of Mr. George Walls from 1st January, 1965 to 31st October, 1967 should be declared to be pensionable service for the reason that, through no fault of his own, his superannuation benefits were not preserved during his secondment from the office of Operator/Inspector (Mosquito Control Service) in the Ministry of Health to an office with the Ben American Cavitant B. of Health to an office with the Pan American Sanitary Bureau.
