ORDER IN COUNCIL Made Under THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE (Chapter 191).

UNDER PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 7 OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Variation of boundaries of District No. 4, West Coast, Demerara) Order, 1957.
- 2. The boundaries of District No. 4, West Coast Demerara set out in the schedule to the Sea Defence Ordinance are hereby varied by the substitution for the northern and western boundaries of the aforesaid district of the boundaries set out in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

On the north by the Essequibo river and the Atlantic Ocean from the common boundary between Plantation Hyde Park and Parika to the Demerara river;

On the west by the common boundary between Plantation Hyde Park and Parika and the prolongation of the said common boundary to the Kent Dam, the Kent Dam to the Boerasirie river, and the Boerasirie upwards to the Boerasirie Service Canal.
