THE SUGAR LEVY ACT 1974

(No. 22 of 1974)

- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 7 OF THE SUGAR LEVY ACT 1974, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE:—
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sugar Levy (Security for Payment) Regulation 1975.
- 2. An exporter of sugar shall give security in the form set out in the Schedule for the due payment by him of the sugar levy payable in respect of sugar to be exported by him.

Now the condition of this obligation is such that if within twenty-one days after the date on which any sugar is exported payment is made to the Comptroller of Customs by the above bounden of such sum as is payable as sugar levy in respect thereof as is required by section 5(1) of the Sugar Levy Act 1974 and if within three months after the date of the said exporation the above bounden complies with the requirements of section 5(2) of that Act, then this obligation shall be void but shall otherwise be and remain in full force and virtue.
