MADE UNDER

THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ORDINANCE, 1953, (No. 5 of 1953).

UNDER SECTION 41 OF THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ORDINANCE, 1953, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Representation of the People (Amendment) Regulations, 1953, and shall be construed and read as one with the Representation of the People Regulations, 1953*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
- 2. Regulation 24 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended— $\,$
 - (a) by the substitution for the words "He shall" in paragraph (a), of the words "If he considers it necessary, he shall,";
 - (b) by the insertion of a comma—
 - (i) between the word "shall" and the word "without"; and
 - (ii) between the word "other" and the word "count", in paragraph (c); and
 - (c) by the deletion of the words "so as to ascertain whether those tickets, so as to" in the fourth line of paragraph (c).
