THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 185).

UNDER SECTION 94 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE AS AMENDED BY SECTION 4 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, 1935, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE POSTMASTER GENERAL WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Parcel Postage Surface Rates (Great Britain and Northern Ireland) (H.M. Forces) Regulations, 1953.
- 2. The rates of postage chargeable on parcels sent by members of Her Majesty's Forces addressed to destinations in Great Britain or Northern Ireland shall be those set out in the second column of the schedule hereto.
- 3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1954.
