REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE BRITISH NATIONALITY ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 100)

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE BRITISH NATIONALITY ORDINANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the British Nationality (Fees) (Amendment Regulations, 1962, and shall be construed and read with the British Nationality (Fees) Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any Regulations amending the same.
- 2. Paragraph (2) of regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the symbol and figures "\$9.60" of the words, symbols and figures "(if the applicant is a British protected person) and \$14.40 (if the applicant is an alien)".
- 3. The schedule to the Principal Regulations as substituted by regulation 2 of the British Nationality (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1952≠, is hereby revoked, and the following schedule substituted therefor:
