RESOLUTION NO. 84

WHEREAS the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change was opened for signature at the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development in Rio de Janeiro, from June 4 - 14, 1992;

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid Convention remained open at the United Nations Headquarters in New York until June 19, 1993;

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid Convention was signed by Guyana on June 13, 1992;

AND WHEREAS participation in the aforesaid Convention enhances our capacity to effectively plan for Global Climate Change as a country with a low lying coast;


AND WHEREAS the Government of Guyana is committed to making continued efforts to combat the effects of Global Climate Change;

AND WHEREAS Guyana became a party to the aforesaid Convention through ratification on August 29, 1994:

RESOLVED,

That the National Assembly endorses the decision to ratify the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.
