WHEREAS the Multilateral Agreement concerning the Operation of Air Services within the Caribbean Community was opened for signature on 6th July, 1996, on the occasion of the Seventeenth Meeting of the Conference of Heads of Government in Barbados:

AND WHEREAS the said Agreement was signed by H.E. Dr. Cheddi Jagan, late President of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana;

AND WHEREAS Article 21 of the said Agreement makes provision for Ratification and deposit of Instruments of Ratification with the Secretary-General of the Community;

AND WHEREAS Article 22 of the said Agreement makes provision for its entry into force upon the deposit of the eight Instrument of Ratification with the Secretary-General;

AND WHEREAS the said Agreement is further testimony of Guyana's commitment to the process of regional co-operation and integration;

AND WHEREAS Guyana stands to benefit from the said Agreement which will provide a mechanism to support the commercial viability of regional air carriers:

RESOLVED, That the National Assembly hereby agree to the Secretary-General of the Caribbean Community being informed of Guyana's intention to ratify the said Agreement and for Guyana to formally ratify the said Agreement by the deposit of an appropriate instrument of ratification.
